WHAT IS A LOGO?

Logos are images, texts, shapes, or a combination of the three that depict the name and purpose of a organization or business. Our new church logo is a "combination logo" consisting of a graphic (stylized image of a tree) combined with the name of the church and a tag-line "Where everyone has room to grow". The stylized image of the tree used in our logo is part of a suite of graphic depictions of trees that are widely available for use in designs. For example, the Servus Credit Union logo is a green circle but there are murals at the Servus Centre that use the same stylized image of a tree for decoration, not as a logo. That is why it is extremely important to use the complete version of the new St. Albert United Church logo - graphic, name and tag-line - on official church materials to clearly communicate the church's new visual identity.

Guidelines for use of the logo are being developed. In the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact me if you have questions about the new logo.
